

This is message 86/2010 from the Valleys and Vale Neighbourhood Watch sent on 12/8/2010. Here is an area wide warning about a scam which appears to be starting up. Residents in Nailsworth and Stonehouse have been phoned by Asian sounding males alledging that the residents had a fault on their computer and asking the resident to log on so they could fix the fault. In the Stonehouse incident the caller asked for debit card details so that a fee of £50.00 could be collected. Neither resident had any problems with their computers so, quite rightly, no such action was taken by the residents. Please advise members to be aware of this scam.
